## **Romios Gold (RG-TSXV)**

Romios Gold reported a small inferred resource on its Newmont Lake property in northwestern British Columbia. That estimate was based largely on results of drilling conducted in the 1980s. At that time, several companies explored in the area now held by Romios, with a focus on finding more deposits like the nearby Eskay Creek discovery. That high-grade gold-silver deposit is now being mined by Barrick. Base metal occurrences in the area were largely ignored by explorers in the 1980s.

NovaGold's galore Creek deposit is in a similar geological setting to Newmont Lake. Galore Creek consists of several deposits that now accumulate to over 1.5 billion tonnes. That deposit was explored decades ago by two major mining companies, but was put aside as being too small. Several years of work by NovaGold has shown that the original cluster of small deposits are actually part of a large mineralized system.

The resource outlined so far at Newmont Lake is most likely only the beginning. An

additional 19 mineral occurrences that were identified by the historic work have only been tested so far by a few widely spaced holes. Work this year at Newmont Lake, and at other Romios properties in the area, will build on a geological data base that suggests the potential for big discoveries.
